Players must register for the season and pay a one-time fee in order to sign up for any of the individual events played during the season. Registration for the season opens on April 1<sup>st</sup>. Click Here to Register

Players will be required to register for each event individually so that we can get a better head count and more accurate pairings each week. Registration for an event will open three weeks prior to the event and close the Friday prior to the event. **Due to limited tee times at host courses, there will be a limit of 60 entries per event, after that point a waiting list will be established**. Players will register for an event by going to <a href="www.hdgolf.org/hajga.asp">www.hdgolf.org/hajga.asp</a> and clicking on the corresponding APPLY button for the event they wish to play in. Players can also enter an event by responding to the invitation email sent 3 weeks prior to an event.

Tee times will be posted 24 hours prior to the event. Results will be posted to the site once the event is completed.

# **Harrisburg Area Junior Golf Association**

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All junior golfers will play to the USGA Rules of Golf and all local rules. A player is responsible for the score of his/her competitors. He/she is responsible to watch all strokes. HONESTY IS EXPECTED AT ALL TIMES. ALL SCORES MUST BE COMPLETE AND ACCURATE.
- 2. The player must register with the starter 10 minutes before their scheduled tee time.
- 3. Proper golf attire is required at all times. Blue jeans, cut-off shorts, tank tops, and tee shirts will not be allowed. Golf shoes (soft spikes required) or sneakers are required.
- 4. UNSPORTMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. LOUD AND/OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE, CHEATING AND/OR THROWING CLUBS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ANY TIME.
- 5. All players must respect the course by raking bunkers, fixing ball marks, and replacing divots where applicable. Trash should be placed in the proper receptacles.
- 6. Caddies and/or motorized carts are not permitted.
- 7. Completion of all rounds is mandatory. In the event of an illness and/or injury <a href="mailto:imfo@hdgolf.org">info@hdgolf.org</a> must be notified immediately.
- 8. Girls may compete with the boys by playing the same tees and in the proper age group.
- 9. All players are responsible for a correct and signed scorecard that must contain the player's and his/her marker's signature. Players are required to wait at the leaderboard until their score has been posted. Spectators and parents may not give advice or walk directly with players. The USGA Rules of Golf rule # 10 clearly defines "advice" and must adhered to by all players, spectators and parents. Parents may observe from a distance, but may not keep score or interpret the rules. Any violation of this rule will result in a player disqualification and suspension from the next tournament
- 10. Players may spectate after the completion of their round, but are not permitted to walk with or to disturb other players.
- 11. A player who is eligible for an award must wait near the scoring area until awards are distributed.
- 12. Any Player or parent who does not follow the above rules will be disqualified and/or suspended from play for either the next event or the remainder of the season.
